The idea for the Disque Foundation began with a charitable medical project. Founder and Executive Director Dr. Fritz Disque was serving in Haiti, along with other volunteer medical professionals from Rush University, after the 2010 earthquake. At that time, Dr. Disque was involved in an emergency C-section that required pediatric advanced life support (PALS). As a board certified physician and practicing anesthesiologist, Fritz noticed a lack of knowledge abroad regarding the basics of PALS. Based on a lack of free education, and time demands required of health care professionals, he felt there was an unmet need for self-directed educational training. He and his colleagues found traditional on-site courses did not fit the constantly improving learning model now available through an online platform.

The resulting convenience of online training and the freedom to personally determine when completion occurs, gives health care professionals extra time to continue saving the lives of the patients they are surrounded by on a daily basis. For this reason, all aspects of the course can be accessed online, and completed from any device with Internet access.

All of the courses were created by board certified medical professionals and adhere to the 2015-2020 AHA standards and guidelines. Courses include many forms of study material, including video demonstrations, audio books and PDF study handbooks. The ACLS, BLS, and PALS courses are eligible for AMA Category 1 Credits™ and the CPR course is eligible for AMA category 2 CME. The Postgraduate Institute of Medicine (PIM), an accredited, online medical certification regulatory organization, has completed a full evaluation of NHCPS courses.

At the start of January 2018 the Disque Foundation will be embarking on their annual foundation trip to empower others to save lives. This year their destination is Nairobi, Kenya, where for 10

days they will be joining forces with the Foundation for International Cardiac & Children's Services (FICCS). The FICCS medical team has completed over 50 successful charity cardiac catheterization procedures, including donated pacemakers. In addition, FICCS has trained over 350 young women in health and hygiene and has provided medical and nutritional support to over 2500 women and children. In Kenya, the foundations will be training and empowering their "superusers," nurses, and medical students with CPR and ACLS skills.
